Current tuition is  
**\$14,800 (2024-2025)**

- Registration fee is \$400
- Marist High School does not charge any fees for Fundraising or Student Activities
- Payments are divided into 10 payments starting in July and ending in April
- Marist will work with families to create flexible payment arrangements

# Financial Assistance



- Average Award per family is \$3,750.
- 92% of financial assistance applicants receive an award
- Currently over 62% of our students receive financial assistance
- 96 First Responder, class of 2028 applicants, received Marist Financial Assistance.



# Class of 2029 Discounts

- A \$300 Early Payment Credit is given for families who pay tuition in full By July 20<sup>th</sup>
- \$1,000 sibling discount for 2<sup>nd</sup> student
- \$2,000 sibling discount for 3<sup>rd</sup> student
- 4<sup>th</sup> sibling in the building attends for free



# Class of 2029 Discounts

- **First Responder Discount**
  - \$1000 (renewable)
  - Parents who are a Fire Fighter, Police Officer, Nurse, Paramedic, Active Military (Only one parent can receive this).
  - The Marist Financial Assistance application must be completed to qualify.



# Academic Scholarships For Freshmen



- **RedHawk Scholarship** \$5,000 annually – \$20,000 total
  - Based on local percentile of 95+ on entrance exam
- **Champagnat Scholarship** \$3,000 annually - \$12,000 total
  - Based on local percentile of 90 to 94 on entrance exam
- **Brothers Scholarship** \$2,000 annually - \$8,000 total
  - Based on local percentile of 85 to 89 on entrance exam
- All renew automatically with “B” average

# Marist Endowed Scholarships

- There are 52 named scholarships with various criteria.
- The Marist Financial Assistance application must be submitted for consideration for these scholarships.
- Named scholarships are awarded to incoming freshman and will renew providing that students meet the scholarship grade and other requirements.



# Work Study



- Marist has over 200 students participating in our work study program
  - Lunch Work Study
    - 5 to 10 minutes commitment per day
  - Before or After School Work Study
    - 30 to 50 minutes a few days per week
    - Flexible with athletes/club schedules
  - Stadium Clean-Ups after football games/events
    - Can have multiple family members volunteer to all earn for tuition credit
- Credit earned each month is applied directly towards the student's tuition

- Marist uses FACTS Grant Aid Assessment to help us organize and analyze family financial assistance applications
- FACTS does not provide any financial assistance they only analyze family data
- Families pay \$30 to FACTS as an application fee

# Important Details

- **MOST IMPORTANT!** – Please submit the application for Financial Assistance on time!
  - Include the first 2 pages of your 2023 1040 tax return form if 2024 is not yet complete
  - Include your 2024 W-2 forms
- Families with siblings currently attending Marist need only to submit one application

# Important Dates for incoming freshmen (Class of 2029)

- **October 25, 2024**– FACTS accepts financial assistance applications for 2024-2025 school year
- **November 11, 2024** – Registration for Entrance Exam Opens
- **December 7, 2024** – Entrance exam
- **December 16, 2024** -- Application for Admission Due
- **February 1, 2025** – Admission decision, student letter notification.
- **February 12, 2025** - Financial Assistance deadline for all families with an incoming Freshmen



# Important Dates for Incoming Freshmen (Continued)

- **March 4, 2025** – Parent information night at 6pm in the Main Gym
- **March 7, 2025** – Incoming Freshmen notified of financial assistance awards. An email will be sent to families by Marist through FACTS
- **March 12, 2025** - \$400 Registration fee is due and course form due
- **June 17, 2025** - \$500 Deposit due to release Freshman schedule in July (deposit applied to tuition)



# Important Dates for Returning Students

- Must I reapply each year?
  - Yes, all families must reapply and generally will receive the same amount (or more) of assistance as the previous year
- April 18, 2025 –Financial Assistance applications deadline for returning students
- May 31, 2025 – Current/Returning Students notified of Financial Assistance Award. An email will be sent to families by Marist through FACTS
