


DECEMBER 2024 MARIST HIGH SCHOOL ALUMNI NEWSLETTER

Tori graduated from Marist in '06 and then Indiana University with a Sports Communications and Broadcast Journalism degree.

She joined the FOX Carolina team on July 31, 2019, moving to Greenville from Syracuse, NY.

"As the only daughter of a high school football coach and English teacher, my love of sports and writing has deep roots in my childhood. I grew up in the suburbs of Chicago, where I played almost every sport. If I wasn't on the field, you could find me cheering on my dad's football team, or the Chicago

Bears/Cubs/Blackhawks/Bulls.

After graduating from Indiana University in 2010, she started her broadcasting career as the weekend sports anchor at KCWY-TV in Casper, Wyoming. After two years, she returned to the Midwest and landed in Toledo, Ohio. After a year of weekend sports at WNWO-TV, she got the opportunity to anchor sports Monday through Friday in Fort Myers, Florida at WZVN-TV. A couple of years later, she headed to Upstate New York.

She switched from sports to news as the weekend anchor at WSTM/WTVH-TV in Syracuse. In those two years, "I learned more about myself and things beyond the gridiron than I could've ever imagined, and decided news is where I belong." That is excellent news for Greenville, SC! STATE CHAMPS!


Marist girls' volleyball team won their 3rd state championship in program history on November 16th. They defeated conference rival and team-ranked-fifth-in-the-US, Benet Academy. It was RedHawks vs. Redwings as the teams battled in a thrilling three-set match in Bloomington, emerging triumphant 19-25, 25-16, and 25-19 in the IHSA Class 4A State Competition. The day before, our girls defeated Lockport (Twp.), 25-14, 25-22. The Marist boys' and girls' volleyball teams currently hold Illinois state volleyball titles in the same calendar year. The win marks Marist's seventh volleyball state championship in school history for the boys' and girls' programs. Jordan Vidovic leads the team as Head Coach, assisted by Kelly Phelan and Avery Jedry. Jordan is a four-time National Coach of the Year, two-time Illinois State Coach of the Year, and two-time AVCA Midwest Coach of the Year. He was inducted into the Illinois Volleyball Hall of Fame in 2022. This past fall, he was inducted into the Marist Hall of Fame. Beyond his family, Jordan credits the many coaches who have supported him along the way. Boy, are we glad he is on our team! Fantastic work, everyone- Let's GO, REDHAWKS!
